The LoW codes relate to the generated quantities only, other codes e.g. chapter 19 10 / 19 12 would relate to waste treatment.

⁽²⁾ This includes incineration with energy recovery and the reprocessing of waste to be used as fuel or other means to generate energy. EXPLANATORY FOOTNOTES

Slovenia

1	Metals separated after incineration (D10) of municipal waste in SI incineration plant are included within cell T8. We do not have data on metals separated after incineration (R1, D10) of municipal waste in foreign incinerators / energy recovery plants.
2	20 01 21* and 20 01 23* are fully included in the Electrical and electronic equipment group.
3	The amounts of bio-waste separated and recycled at source (home-composting) is not monitored and consequently not included neither in the amounts of recycled municipal waste nor in the total amounts of generated municipal waste.
4	The amounts of separately collected municipal waste include amounts of all waste from groups 15 01 and 20, except the amounts of waste with waste codes 20 03 01, 20 01 99, 20 03 02, 20 03 03, 20 03 99, because this type of waste is usually not collected separately for the purpose of recycling.
